

Cycling Southland 2010/2011 Selection Policy



1. Purpose

This policy exists to set guidelines for the use of both selectors and riders in relation to the selection of all Cycling Southland representative teams for both road and track disciplines.

3. Responsibilities – Selectors/Riders

Selectors

- Will attend as many local/Regional/National events as possible.
- Communicate with the Regional Coach over selections.
- Will provide regular updates to National Selectors of outstanding performances.

Riders

- Inform selectors of events to be considered for by completing Event Expression of interest Form found on the Cycling Southland Website .

- Inform selectors of outstanding results and performances at Regional, National and International level.
- Regularly inform selectors of progress and form at major competitions.

4. Key Components of Selection

The following will be considered by the selection committee when selecting representative teams:

- Rider's ability to meet qualification time standards.
- Southland Championship results.
- National/International competition results.
- A rider's value in a team and ability to assist another rider achieve a result.
- Positions available in the team.

The Selection Committee reserves the right not to fill all available positions on both track and road disciplines.

Time qualification standards are an indication and a goal for a rider to target. Being outside the time qualification standard does not mean they will not be considered for Southland Teams.

5. Appeal Process

A rider who has not been selected in a representative team may lodge a request to the selectors to be reconsidered within 48hours of the official team being released by the selectors.

The only basis of appeal is on the rider's ability to be competitive in a national field and must be supported by times/results at national and international events. The selection committee will then consult each other to reconsider the rider's request.

6. National Team's Time Trial Selection

All riders wishing to represent Cycling Southland in the National Team Time Trials Championships to be held in Hamilton from October 21-25th shall notify the selectors via Cycling Southland Office of their intention to compete before **14th July 2010** by emailing the expression of interest form to office@cyclingsouth.org.nz , att: selectors. The Selection

Committee will place riders in the appropriate team based on the following criteria. Squads can then be formed and coaches appointed for particular squads.

- Positions to fill
- Previous performances in Team Time Trials/Individual Time Trials.
- Recent road racing results at Club/National/International level.
- Grade a rider competes in at Club and National races.
- Rider's ability to add value to a team.

7. Club Road Nationals

All riders wishing to represent Cycling Southland in the Club Road Nationals, to be held in Wanganui in May 2011 shall notify the selectors of their intention before 31st January by emailing the expression of interest form to office@cyclingsouth.org.nz , att: selectors. The Selection Committee will place riders in the appropriate category based on the following criteria.

- See Point 4. Above
- The contribution to the club in a positive manner over the preceding season.

8. Elite Road Race and Time Trial Selection

All riders wishing to represent Cycling Southland in the Elite Road Race and Time Trial, to be held in Christchurch in January 2011 shall notify the selectors of their intention before 20th November by emailing the expression of interest form to office@cyclingsouth.org.nz , att: selectors. The Selection Committee will place riders in the appropriate category based on the following criteria.

Automatic Selection criteria

- Top 10 in their respective category the following year in this race
- The first three place getters at the Southland Road Race Championships in each grade shall be automatic selections, providing the field has more than 10 riders.
- The first place getter at the Southland Time Trial Championships in each grade shall be an automatic selection for the Time Trial Event.

Non Automatic Selection Criteria

- Previous performances in National/International road events.
- Results at recent Regional/National road events.

- Results and performances at Cycling Southland Club races.
- Rider's ability to add value to the team and help others succeed.

9. Elite & Age Group Track Championships

This team will be named upon completion of the Southland Track championships in January 2011.

National Track Championships have restrictions on entries and the following criteria will be used to determine a rider's selection to the National Championships for all grades.

- Rider's performances at Southland Championships.
- Previous results at National Championships.
- Results and times at National/International Carnivals.
- Rider's automatic qualification in timed events.
- Rider's ability to be competitive at National Championships.
- Rider's ability to add value to the team and help others succeed.
- Positions available in the team
- Long term rider potential

Automatic Selection criteria

(Note: remit at recent Bike R&T AGM was passed for selectors to review qualification standards)

9.1 - The following is a list of automatic selection time standards to gain entry to the National Track Championships. The following times are based on the 2008 Nationals set by BikeNZ. The automatic time standards and event entries into the National Track Championships is subject to change, any changes will be notified and the Cycling Southland Selection Policy will be amended accordingly.

9.2 - There are two time qualification standards, one for outdoor tracks (O); these times are set by BikeNZ for automatic qualification into the National Champs. The second time qualification standard is set by Cycling Southland selectors and is based on previous times that would be competitive at the National Champs held indoors (I).

9.3 - When the National Championships are held indoors, the Indoor (I) qualification time standard will be used. When the National Championships are held outdoor, the Outdoor (O) qualification time standard will be used.

9.4 - When BikeNZ sets automatic time qualification standards for indoor tracks, this Policy will be amended accordingly.

10. National Madison Championships

Non Automatic Selection Criteria

- Previous performances in National/International Road/ Track events.
- Results at recent Regional/National Track events.
- Rider's ability to add value to the team and help others succeed.
- Proven technical Madison skills.

11. Oceania Championships

The Oceania Championships will be held in Adelaide from November 24th-28th in 2010. All riders wishing to represent Cycling Southland in the Oceania Games (U19 & Senior Only for 2011 year) shall notify the selectors of their intention before 31st August by emailing the expression of interest form to office@cyclingsouth.org.nz , att: selectors The Selection Committee will place riders in the appropriate category based on the following criteria.

Non Automatic Selection Criteria

- Previous performances in National/International road/track events.
- Results at recent Regional/National road/track events.
- Results and performances at National Championships.
- Rider's ability to add value to the team and help others succeed.
- Competitive times in training/racing

12. Other Events

For all other Cycling Southland representative teams the Selection Committee will base selections on the criteria set out in (4) above.

13. Term

This Policy is effective from June 20th 2010 until further notice. Policy is subject to change and any amendments will be notified to members and published on the Cycling Southland website at www.cyclingsouth.org.nz.
